Stay healthy – Be ready

- Get out of bed in time
- Eat a healthy breakfast

Be prepared

- Computer charged and headphones on if necessary
- Camera and microphone off at the start of the lesson, unless your teacher asks differently*

- Dress appropriately
- Quiet room
- No distracting background on camera
- Mobile phone off, or switched to silent.

- Ask questions or contribute by using the raise hand icon
- Follow the guidance of the teacher
