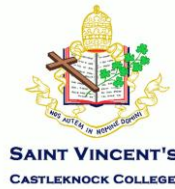


Transition Year Unit.



Subject: Gaeilge

Number of Periods per week: 3

Class Teacher: A.White

Aims and objective:

To prepare the students for the Aural & Oral Leaving Certificate Irish course.

To encourage and enable students to improve on their standard of Irish, by working both together as a class, and individually.

To enforce confidence in listening to and speaking Irish.

To teach each student how to answer exam style questions in the cluastuiscent (aural Irish tape) section of the exam.

Course content:

Students will have the chance to learn new vocabulary that will help them when completing weekly cluastuiscentí.

Students will work together to create and record their own cluastuiscent, as well as compose questions based on it for their classmates to answer.

Method of assessment:

Weekly cluastuiscentí (Irish listening tapes) and exam style questions.

At the end of the module, students will work in groups to create their own cluastuiscent, i.e. they will record their voices discussing certain topics, e.g. the weather, and they will compose questions for their classmates to answer while listening to their recordings.
