

## TY Philosophy Module (TMG)

**Subject:** Philosophy (P4C)

**Number of Periods per week:** 1

**Class Teacher:** TMG

### **Aims and objective:**

- To introduce students to the richness of philosophy – learning by ‘doing’ philosophy rather than learning ‘about’ philosophy.
- Engaging with the P4C (Philosophy for Children) methodology of philosophy.

### **Course content:**

- Students will be guided through a variety of topics and resources that will stimulate philosophical thinking and discussion.
- We will use the *Think/Pair/Share* methodology throughout the module. No two classes or groups will be the same because the students’ philosophical questions dictate the content and development of the module.
- Students will be encouraged to think independently and to develop their skills of critical thinking, analysis, synthesis, discernment, and argument.

### **Method of assessment:**

- Given the student-focused and participatory nature of the module, traditional assessment is not appropriate. Assessment will be based on the level and veracity of engagement of each student.
